Nettles and Thorns	All	The group is supervised by a leader at all times. High risk areas avoided and leaders to deter looking in the nettled areas/ thorny areas	8	2	16	Adequately controlled
Stings and bites	All	Make sure all young people aware of what bugs are around – describe bees and hornets and wasps – educate what to leave alone – show prompt cards – severe allergies to be noted before commencing trail	6	3	16	Adequately Controlled
