Horseplay	All	Activity to be supervised by a instructor, leader or Responsible adults. Session to be stopped if behaviour prevents the instructor effectively supervising the group. Seated area for those waiting	6	2	12	Adequately Controlled
Environmental factors	All	Instructors to be aware of hypo/hyperthermia All activities cancelled if conditions are deemed to endanger safety – i.e. lightning or high winds	8	2	16	Adequately Controlled
Falling from height	All	Group leaders instructed not to let young people climb higher than 1 meter from the ground	4	4	16	Adequately controlled
Falling back on to someone else	All	The activity is limited to 20 participants. Spotters stand to side of climber Crash mats at base of wall	4	3	12	Adequately controlled
Cutting or scraping hands	Participants	Climbers warned not to put their hands on the top of the wall.	4	4	16	Adequately controlled
